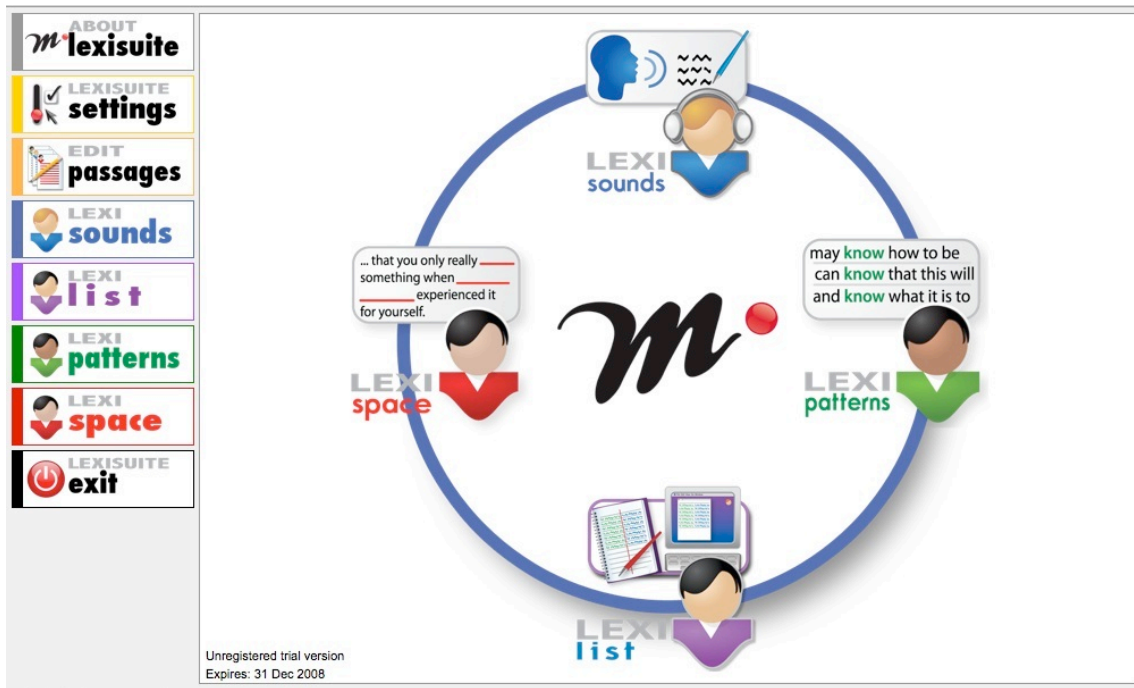

The opening screen looks like this:



When you download LexiSuite 4 teaching programs are available to you: **LexiSounds**, **LexiList**, **LexiPatterns** and **LexiSpace**. The **Edit Passages** program is also available, a program that allows you to create your own materials for students. These can be exported in a file which can be distributed to students for importing into their own copy of LexiSuite. If the students do not have a copy of LexiSuite you can create practice worksheets and tests for them in the program's database.

During the trial period all programs are available. After the expiry of the trial period, a separate license for any or all of the 5 programs must be purchased.

LexiSuite itself is the "parent program", the platform which is needed to run one or more of the 5 LexiSuite programs.

In the current version of LexiSuite which you are using, there is no sample data. In **Lesson 1** you will learn how to create some simple materials with text. This will give you a preliminary experience of the wide range of possibilities offered by **LexiSuite**, in particular, **LexiList**, **LexiPatterns** and **LexiSpace**. In later lessons, which will be made available on the Momentum website (on at least a weekly basis until the end of 2008) you will learn how to export and import material, how to work with multimedia files, including mp3 audio files, jpeg graphic files and QuickTime movies. The functions of **LexiSounds** will be introduced at this time. Later lessons will also explain the functions of the individual programs in depth.
